How to get started and what you need to know?

- Qualified owner/managers use a pre-designed mobile app as a checklist to ensure all required systems and features are code compliant.
- Deficiencies noted are flagged for corrective action.
- A completed form is submitted to the fire department in an approved format.
- Self-assessment audit will establish a relationship of trust and goodwill with the fire department.
- **High-speed internet connection is required to take the course.**
- **Course is offered online and is self-paced.**
