## Why should you be well versed in Fire Safety Code?

- Building owners or their agents are responsible for Fire Safety Code compliance as mandated by the National Fire code of Canada + all provincial codes within Section 1.1?
- Conducting routine fire prevention assessments can provide a high level of building and tenant safety.
- Fire knowledge is inexpensive preventative maintenance.
- Regular assessment of fire safety code compliance is a sound asset protection strategy.

## What should building owners and/or managers know?

- How engineered fire protection systems are designed to protect the building by detecting fire, alerting occupants, and preventing the spread of fire.
- Direct involvement in fire prevention will yield other safety and maintenance benefits.
- Regular Fire Safety Code compliance assessments provide tenant education opportunities.
- Build trust with tenants through a demonstrated commitment to safety.

## How to get started and what you need to know?

- Qualified owner/managers use a predesigned mobile app as a checklist to ensure all required systems and features are code compliant.
- Deficiencies noted are flagged for corrective action.
- A completed form is submitted to the fire department in an approved format.
- Self-assessment audit will establish a relationship of trust and goodwill with the fire department.
- High-speed internet connection is required to take the course.
- Course is offered online and is self-paced.
